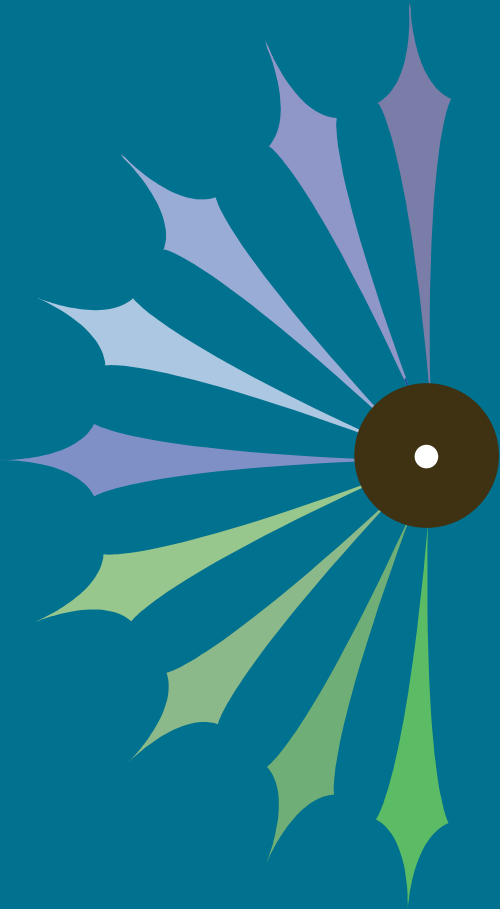

This one day symposium for ophthalmologists will cover innovations and applications of current knowledge related to glaucomatous disease and treatment.
